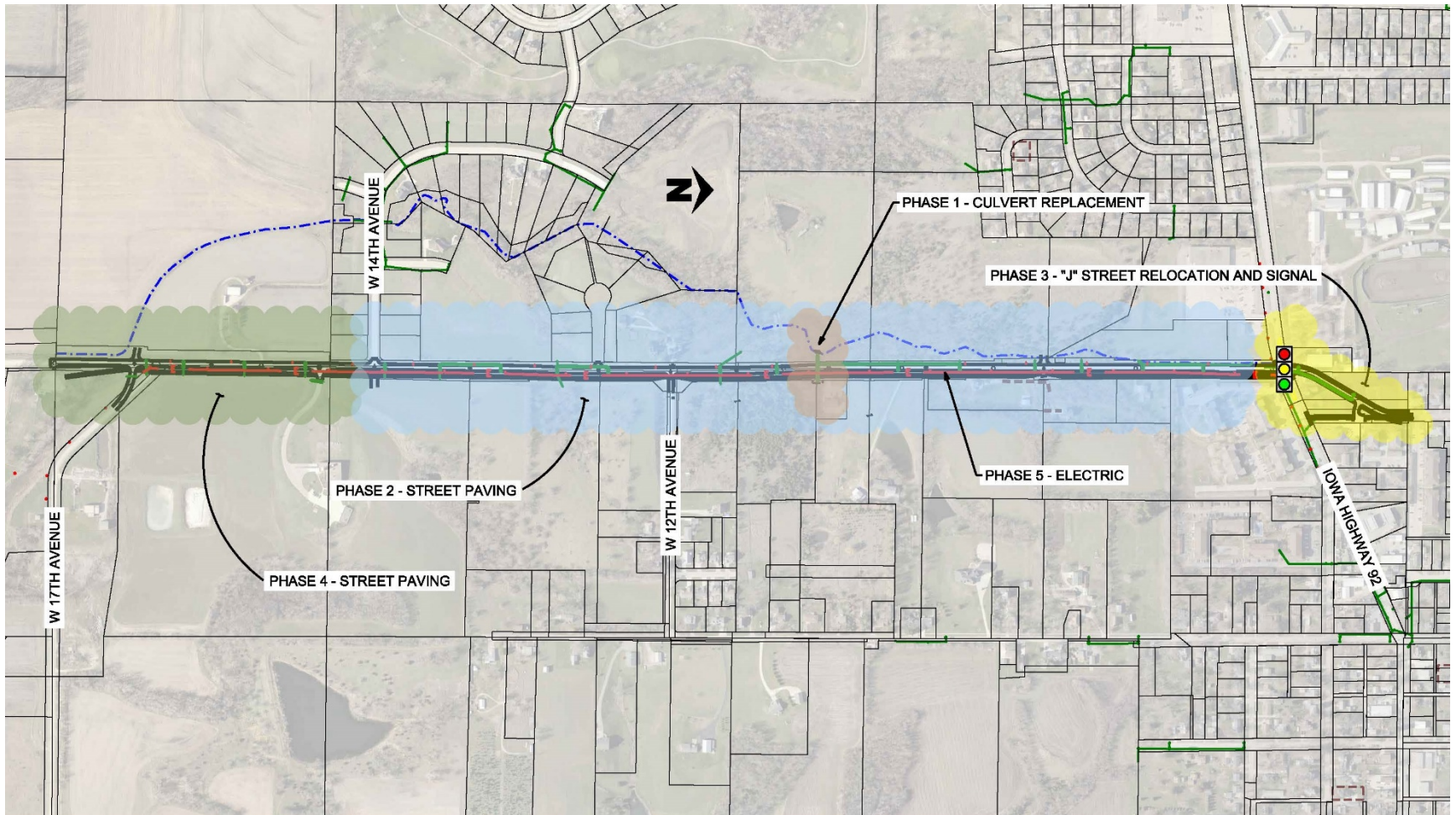
Roadway Type and Typical Section

Typical Section



- Collector roadway
- 31' wide street with access control
- Consolidation of driveways and full implement with development
- Auxiliary lanes at major intersections
- Multi-use trail – east side
- Utility corridor for future buried utilities
- Street lights and trees along multi-use path
- 70'-100' right of way

Project Phases & Cost		
Phase 1	Major culvert replacement	\$119,000.00
Phase 2	K Street, W 14 th Street – 2 nd Avenue	\$3,194,000.00
Phase 3	Relocation of J Street and signal	\$857,000.00
Phase 4	K Street, W 17 th Street – W 14 th Street	\$1,150,000.00
Phase 5	Underground electrical	\$2,409,000.00

Project Funding Source

- Potential funding and phasing
 - STP funds (\$600,000) FY 2019
 - CIP funds (\$119,000) for culvert replacement
 - Enhancement funds (trail and street trees)
 - Special assessments (local road portion only)
 - Voluntary assessments
 - Local capital improvement funds
