

SPECIAL SESSION – AUGUST 7, 2017

The City Council met in special session at 4:30 p.m. on August 7, 2017. Mayor Kelly B. Shaw called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, John Parker and Greta Southall. Warren County Board of Supervisors Doug Shull, Dean Yordi and Crystal McIntyre. Mark Cory of Ahlers Law Firm, City Manager Ryan Waller, Community Development Director Chuck Burgin, Warren County Auditor Traci VanderLinden and City Clerk Diana Bowlin. Absent: Council members Pam Pepper and Brad Ross

The Mayor and City Council meet in joint session with the Warren County Board of Supervisors. Dean Yordi, Warren County Board of Supervisor and Mark Cory of Ahlers Law Firm discussed Iowa Code Section 346.27 which allows:

- A joint venture with the City and possibly the Indianola Schools for a new joint county and city building.
- A committee would have to be established consisting of one Warren County Board of Supervisor, one City Council member and another member selected by the governing bodies.
- The building would have to be within the city limits and it would be a public purpose building.
- Each entity, depending on the use of the building, would pay a percentage of cost.
- This would have to be voted on by the citizens of Warren County. The ballot would state what each entity would use the building/location for.

Meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m. on a motion by Clark and seconded by Gezel.
