

SPECIAL SESSION – MAY 11, 2017

The Council of Indianola, Iowa will meet on the above date in special session pursuant to law and the rules of said Council and in accordance with the terms of a Notice of Meeting, a copy of which was served on each member of the Council within the time required by law and accepted in writing by each member thereof, said notice of meeting being as follows:

1. Enter into closed session in accordance with Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(i) to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session

and for such other business as may properly come before the City Council.

The City Council met in special session in the Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. on May 11, 2017. Council member Pam Pepper called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Mayor Kelly Shaw, Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, John Parker, Pam Pepper, Brad Ross and Greta Southall. Also present was City Attorney Doug Fulton.
