Passed and approved on the 5th day of May, 2014.

A public hearing and first consideration amending Chapter 122 of the code of ordinances by adding ice cream vendors in Indianola was held. There were no objections either oral or written. City Attorney Maria Brownell read an e-mail from Joe Doering, Outside Scoop Ice Cream- 601 ½ N. Jefferson, requesting the designated route and packaged ice cream be deleted from the ordinance and the license fee be adjusted. Council members discussed the following which would be deleted, added or modified to the ordinance:

- Vendor should be able to adjust the route
- License fee
- The wording “individually packaged ice cream or frozen desserts” will be removed from the ordinance
- Safety – additional wording will be added to the ordinance

It was moved by Parker and seconded by Mathieu to approve the following Resolution setting May 19, 2014 as a public hearing and first consideration to amend Chapter 122 to allow ice cream trucks in the City of Indianola. Question was called for and on voice vote the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously.

Council member Marchant introduced the following resolution entitled, “RESOLUTION APPROVING CONTRACT AND BOND” for the US Highway 65/69 Reconstruction Project to Concrete Technologies, Inc. of Urbandale, Iowa. Council member Parker seconded the motion to adopt. On roll call the vote was, AYES: Pepper, Mathieu, Southall, Parker, Ross and Marchant. NAYS: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously and the following resolution duly adopted.

Upon the final consideration of an amendment to A-1, R-1, R-2, R-3 and R-4 zoning classification that would require 15 day written notification to property owners within 200' of development of sites exceeding one acre or more, as well as Planning and Zoning Commission recommendation and City Council approval, Pepper moved and Ross seconded to adopt ORDINANCE NO. 1530 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF INDIANOLA, IOWA CHAPTER 165, ZONING REGULATIONS, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR DEVELOPMENT ON MORE THAN ONE ACRE IN A-1, R-1, R-2, R-3, AND R-4 ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS." On roll call the vote was, AYES: Mathieu, Southall, Parker, Ross, Marchant and Pepper. NAYS: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously and the ordinance to be effective upon publication.

Upon the final consideration to change a portion of North "C" Street, 174' South of West Girard from one-way to two-way traffic, Mathieu moved and Ross seconded to adopt ORDINANCE NO. 1531 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF INDIANOLA, IOWA, BY CHANGING A PORTION OF 'C' STREET BETWEEN CLINTON AVENUE TO GIRARD AVENUE TO ALLOW SOUTHBOUND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC." On roll call the vote was, AYES: Southall, Parker, Ross, Marchant, Pepper and Mathieu. NAYS: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously and the ordinance to be effective upon publication.

Meeting adjourned on a motion by Marchant and seconded by Mathieu .
