Minutes

The Indianola City Council met in regular session at 4:00 PM on April 6, 2022 in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Stephanie Erickson called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Heather Hulen, John Parker, Ron Dalby, Gwen Schroder, Christina Beach, Steve Richardson and Mayor Erickson. Absent: None.

Council Member Richardson moved to approve the Consent Agenda and Dalby seconded it. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Hulen, Parker, Dalby, Schroder, Beach, Richardson. NAYS: None. Whereas the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda was as follows:

- Approval of Agenda
- Approval of an amended liquor license for Fiesta Jalepeno.

Council Member Parker moved to enter into closed session at 4:01 PM in accordance with Iowa Code Section 21.5 (1)(i) to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session. Council Member Richardson moved to approve Resolution 2022-067 approving an employment agreement with Benjamin Reeves for City Manager. Council Member Schroder seconded it. In discussion, Mayor Erickson welcomed Mr. Reeves to Indianola. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Hulen, Parker, Dalby, Schroder, Beach, Richardson. NAYS: None. Whereas the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously.
