Meeting Minutes – June 23, 2022

Dan called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

Motion by Bob, second by Grant to approve the June 2, 2022 meeting minutes. Motion approved.

Dan indicated he needs to tune the Piano located at Savor the Rise and order a replacement string for it. Dan will coordinate with Jackie to order the string. Dan said the piano located at Bob's Custom Trophy could use a tuning as well. A resident did complain about the piano at Bob's Custom Trophy blocking the sidewalk. Dan will check with his daughter to see if the piano can be moved to allow for more sidewalk space. Kim will check with Kamie Haynes about hosting a piano in a future month. The group agreed to pass on the organ that has been offered to IPAC. Kim will distribute flyers once the sponsors have been added to the copy.

Bob has assembled packets for the art festival vendors. Grant has scheduled social media posts every other day to highlight the artists. Grant will also tag the sponsors and participating organizations in the posts. Bob will contact additional wineries to sell bottles of wine as he has not had any progress with the wineries he previously contacted. Monica has secured four high school face painters. Monica will coordinate with Jackie to order painting supplies.

Jackie reviewed IPAC's income and expenses and indicated a net amount of \$801 is available to buy garbage bags, pay for a banner and rent a portable toilet. Parker signs will produce the banner for \$166 once copy is provided by Grant. The group agreed one ADA compliant portable toilet will be sufficient. Jackie said the council did approve the request to close Girard Ave for the day and approved the noise permit for music. Jackie said Culinary Nomad food truck has confirmed their attendance.

Bob will check with Larry McConnell about providing a portable hot dog/drink cart for the day. Rita Bresnan has lined up enough pianists to play the piano under the gazebo for the day. Kim will check with Megan Shipley about hosting a canvas paint class during the festival.

Dan said he has had no luck soliciting food/drink donations but will contact Hy-Vee and City State Bank.

The group agreed to meet again on Thursday, July 14th at 6:00 pm at Buxton Park to finalize plans for the festival.

The regular monthly meeting will be held on Thursday July 28th at 6:00 pm in council chambers.

Motion by Bob, second by Monica, to adjourn the meeting at 6:45 pm. Motion carried.
