Minutes

1. Capital Improvement Plan Presentation

Asst. City Manager/CFO Andrew Lent presented the Capital Improvement Plan to Council Members.

The presentation included information on the following:

- Policy
- Benefits of a CIP
- Vehicles and Equipment
- Infrastructure
 - General Fund - mainly Parks/Rec and Library
 - Street - Discussion on road plans, asphalt overlays
 - WRRD
 - Sanitary Sewer
 - Stormwater Utility
- Issues and Concerns

Council members noted they would like to have a discussion on the old Wastewater Treatment Plan in a future study session.

2. Discussion regarding "Wonder on Buxton," a Hometown Pride project.

Parks and Recreation Director Doug Bylund provided the history of the project, the cloud sculpture storytelling series, county lawn & storytelling tour, banners/spinning art, community partners, funding contributors, and total anticipated costs. Heidi Levine and Jen Pfifer-Malany, members of the Wonder on Buxton Committee, were in attendance to discuss the Wonder on Buxton project.

Heidi discussed funding and the dollar-for-dollar match that the Iowa Great Places Grant requires. They have raised \$55,000 for the project (\$81,000 contributions total includes city contribution for signage).

The cloud sculpture series was discussed. Council would like to have more information on what the clouds will be made of, size/dimension, and the artwork being placed on it.

Heidi noted that some items in the plan will require council action, such as the light pole art and sidewalk inlays, if the grant is awarded to Indianola.
