The fourth candidate requested a closed session. Commissioner Trotter moved to enter into closed session according to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(i) to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session. Miller seconded the motion. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Miller and Trotter. NAYS: None. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Trotter moved to exit the closed session and Miller seconded it. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Miller and Trotter. NAYS: None. The motion was unanimously approved.

The Commission interviewed the last candidates in open session.
