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Indianola Public Arts Commission Meeting Minutes – November 17, 2022

Bob called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

The September minutes were unanimously approved.

There was agreement that the dates for the 2023 Arts Festival will be Saturday, July 29 and Sunday, July 30.

Following discussion, Grant moved to increase the registration for artists from \$50 to \$75 with applications due by April 1, 2023. Applications will ask artists to consider donating an item for auction to support the Festival. Justin seconded; the motion passed.

Discussion on providing lunches ended in a decision to hold off on any commitment, pending food vendor interest and pursuit of sponsorships. Bob will check on lodging options for artists on the Simpson College campus. DMMO will have finished by then and students won't be arriving yet.

We should confirm the availability of parking for artists. Bob will call Simpson Security (Chris Frerichs) seeking confirmation of availability of the baseball parking lot, including for a motor home.

The post calling for artists will be up by December 1 or shortly thereafter. Returning artists will not be required to submit jury information. Justin moved to approve the Call for Artists as drafted by Bob with slight tweaks. The motion was seconded by Grant and approved. Bob is to be reimbursed for the costs related to the ad.

Grant moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:31 p.m. Tim seconded the motion and the motion carried.
