Call to Order

The Indianola City Council met in regular session at 6:00 PM on October 23, 2023, in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Stephanie Erickson called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Christina Beach, John Parker, Steve Richardson, Gwen Schroder, Josh Rabe, Ron Dalby (via phone). Absent: None.

Public Comment

No public comment was offered.

Consent Agenda

Agenda item 5B, a resolution approving a projecting sign over public right-of-way at 216 W Salem, was pulled from the consent agenda on a request by Council Member Parker. Council Member Richardson moved to approve the Consent Agenda and Rabe seconded it. Question was called for and on voice vote the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda was as follows:

- Approval of the Civil Service Commission list of applicants certified eligible for the position of Police Officer.

Council Member Richardson moved to approve Resolution 2023-208 granting approval of a projecting sign over public right-of-way at 216 West Salem Avenue, Indianola, Warren County, Iowa and Beach seconded it. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Beach, Dalby, Richardson, Schroder, Rabe. NAYS: None. ABSTAIN: Parker, due to a conflict of interest.

Old Business

Council Member Beach moved to approve the third consideration of an ordinance amending sections 15.04 and 17.06 of the City Code of the City of Indianola, Iowa, for the purpose of increasing the compensation of the Mayor, City Council Members, and Members of the Indianola Municipal Utility (IMU) Board of Trustees. Council Member Richardson seconded it. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Beach, Parker, Dalby, Richardson, Rabe. NAYS: Schroder. Whereas the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Council Member Rabe moved to approve Resolution 2023-209 approving an amendment to the Wellness Policy and Parker seconded it. On roll call, the vote was AYES: Beach, Parker, Dalby, Richardson, Schroder, Rabe. NAYS: None. Whereas the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously.
