Meeting Notes:

- Previous minutes approved
- Next meeting
 - Picking chair at the next meeting
 - New city manager wants to come to the next meeting
- July 12, 2025 proposed date for the Art Tag Sale
 - Farmers Market has an event on the 12th, let's do it the same hours as they do theirs (8 am-12 pm)
 - There's about 30 pieces, and we've already sold three. They need to be priced. Money goes into the general IPAC fund. Work with Aaron (from the city) for advertising. Location - Regions - hallway
 - Rachel volunteered to help Bob price them
 - July 12th event - Cash or check or card payments, no change - donations accepted
- **Illuminate Indianola:**
 - BRAVO approved, giving us an extra \$2000 towards the project.
- **Indianola Summer Art Festival**
 - Grant made a motion to approve advertising fees and feather banners, not to exceed \$300.
 - Sign up genius is under Justin's personal email; Cassandra asked for him to update it to the arts@indianola.gov email. She's going to make the Indianola account. We need volunteers for set up, tear down, booth sitters/welcome table.
 - Bob will start working on the map to send to Grant
 - 29 artists and 10 food trucks
 - Two full sets of posters were distributed to all members of the IPAC committee for advertising and the musical lineup
