

SPECIAL SESSION – OCTOBER 30, 2017

The City Council met in special session at 6:00 p.m. on October 30, 2017 in the City Hall Conference Room. Mayor Kelly B. Shaw called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, John Parker, Pam Pepper, Brad Ross and Greta Southall. Also present was City Attorney Doug Fulton.

It was moved by Ross and seconded by Parker to go into closed session in accordance with Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(c) to discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation and in accordance with Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(i) to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session.

It was moved by Ross and seconded by Parker to return to regular session. Question was called for and on voice vote the Mayor declared the motion carried unanimously.

Meeting adjourned on a motion by Clark and second by Pepper.
